##### **John Paul Landing Park**

John Paul Landing Park located at 24202 West Road in Cypress has been awarded the 2018 Parks and Natural Areas Award for “Projects Over \$500,000” by the Houston-Galveston Area Council. H-GAC established the Parks and Natural Areas Awards Program in 2016 to highlight best practices and innovative approaches to creating and improving parks and natural areas.

The 65 acre Park offers a man-made fishing lake, bridges and boardwalks, picnic areas and benches, playgrounds, outdoor pavilions, hike and bike trails, and an education center.

#### **Trail Updates**

##### **George Bush Park – Nobel Road Hike-and-Bike Trail**

A trail project by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is still ongoing on the Noble Road Hike-and-Bike Trail within George Bush Park. This section of trail is projected to remain closed until summer 2019 because of the massive Addicks and Barker Dam Safety Construction Project.

Also closed is Noble Road at State Highway 6 and the Noble Road Trail parking lot.

##### **Terry Hershey Park – Terry Hershey Trail**

The Terry Hershey Trail from Park Row to the Addicks Reservoir is closed because of the Corps of Engineers’ dam safety project. This section of trail will remain closed until the summer of 2019.
