Trail Updates

George Bush Park – Nobel Road Hike-and-Bike Trail

A trail project by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers is still ongoing on the Noble Road Hike-and-Bike Trail within George Bush Park. This section of trail is projected to remain closed until summer 2019 because of the massive Addicks and Barker Dam Safety Construction Project.

Also closed is Noble Road at State Highway 6 and the Noble Road Trail parking lot.

Terry Hershey Park – Terry Hershey Trail

The Terry Hershey Trail from Park Row to the Addicks Reservoir is closed because of the Corps of Engineers' dam safety project. This section of trail will remain closed until the summer of 2019.
